THE DEATH • THE WARREN REPORT

This documentary recording, for the first time, recreates the death of President John F. Kennedy through the voices of eyewitnesses. Asst. White House press secretary Malcolm Kilduff describes the tense atmosphere anticipated in Dallas prior to the arrival of the President. Congressman Earle Cabell and his wife, Elizabeth, report what they saw from the motorcade. Charles Brehm, who stood 12 feet from the presidential limousine when the fatal bullet was fired, recalls the sound of the three shots he heard. Another witness to the event, S. M. Holland, makes a startling revelation. Father Oscar Huber recounts the last rites he performed over the dead President. The shooting of Lee Harvey Oswald is told on the scene, in vivid detail; the fatal shot is clearly audible.

This album also presents the views of both sides on the raging controversy between members of the Warren Commission and its chief detractors, authors *Mark Lane* and *Edward Jay Epstein*. The skeptics argue that the President's assassin would never have been convicted by a jury. Members of the Warren Commission, notably House minority leader Gerald R. Ford and Professor Wesley J. Liebeler, insist that the evidence proves otherwise. But the American public is really the jury.
