Kennedy Slaying Toy Going on Sale

London

A "do-it-yourself" kit enabling the buyer to reconstruct the assassination of President John F. Kennedy goes on sale in Britain March 23, it was announced yesterday.

nounced yesterday.
The kit contains scale models of the Dallas assasination site and full background information for the home sleuth.

The kit is manufactured by Jonathan Capt Ltd. and will sell for \$1.90.

RIFLE

There also is a full-scale drawing of the rifle used by

Lee Harvey Oswald to kill the President.

The three originators of the kit are Michael Rand and Howard Loxton, of the publishing firm, and Len Deighton, author of best-selling criminal and spy novels such as "Funeral in Berlin" and "The Ipcress File."

TASTE

At a news conference, Deighton said he did not feel the kit, despite its macabre nature, constituted any violation of good taste.

"Anything which helps readers to solve the assassination for themselves is in the spirit of public inquiry," he said.

Other items in the kit include a photograph of the assassination, a photocopy of the official autopsy report of the President and blowup photos of the President's bloodstained shirt and jacket
