Oswald Play in Atlanta

"Lee Harvey Oswald: A Far Mean Streak of Independence Brought on by Neglect" will have its American premiere next Wednesday in Georgia's Theater Atlanta. Michael Hastings's four-character drama first reached the stage Nov. 22, 1966, the third anniversary of President Kennedy's assassination, at London's Hampstead Theater Club. Peter Coe directed it then.

Part of the 2½-hour drama is based on the 26-volume report of the Warren Commission. Most of it consists of interviews with Oswald's mother and wife. A paperback edition of the play has been published here by Penguin Books.

The cast will include Terrell Bennett in the title role, Arlene Nadel and Muriel Moore. The presentation is being directed by Jay Broad, managing director of the Atlanta group.
