He is William L. Pierce, who runs the anti-Semitic, rightwing National Youth Alliance in Arlington, Va. Pierce, who has a PhD. in physics and prefers to be called "doctor," was a self-admitted "personal friend" of George Lincoln Rockwell, the late fuhrer of the American Nazi Party. After Rockwell's death, Pierce became the Nazis' "assistant executive officer" and "ideological officer."

It was in this capacity that Pierce recorded a "dial-a-hate" message declaring "there is only one effective way to deal with rampaging blacks on our campuses - and in our cities and that is to kill them."

In 1968, Pierce was found selling "Negro control equipment" out of his Virginia home. His 'equipment" ranged from riot guns to chemical mace.
