LOS ANGELES, SEPT. 14 (AP)-A FORMER PRESIDENT OF CUBA SAID TODAY A REVOLUTION FOR FIDEL CASTRO'S OVERTHROW "COULD HAPPEN WITHIN A YEAR."

DR. MANUEL URRUTIA, WHO SAID HE RESIGNED AS CUBA'S PRESIDENT IN 1959 BECAUSE OF THE CUBAN PREMIER'S "BETRAYAL OF HIS COUNTRY TO THE COMMU-NISTS," TOLD A NEWS CONFERENCE:

"AT LEAST 10 ORGANIZATIONS IN THIS COUNTRY AND IN LATIN AMERICA ARE BEGINNING TO WORK TOGETHER TO PLANSSUCH AN OVERTHROW."

DR. URRUTIA, NOMINAL PRESIDENT OF THE CASTRO GOVERNMENT FOR ITS FIRST SIX MONTHS IN 1959, SAID HE HEADS AN ALLIANCE OF SEVERAL REVOLUTIONARY ORGANIZATIONS.

"I CAME TO LOS ANGELES TO SPEAK TO THE CUBAN PEOPLE OF LOS ANGELES ABOUT OUR PURPOSE, WHICH IS TO UNIFY THE REVOLUTIONARY FORCES THAT ARE FIGHTING AGAINST CASTRO."

HE DENIED A REPORT THAT HE TOLD THE NEWS CONFERENCE HIS GROUP HAS MARKED CASTRO FOR ASSASSINATION WITHIN THE NEXT 60 TO 90 DAYS.

A LOCAL AIDE SAID THE MISUNDERSTANDING AROSE BECAUSE OF A PARTIAL LANGUAGE BARRIER BETWEEN DR. URRUTIA AND REPORTERS.

THE NEWS CONFERENCE WAS ANNOUNCED TO NEWS MEDIA LAST WEEK BY A LOCAL CUBAN ORGANIZATION.

URRUTIA, NOMINAL PRESIDENT OF THE CASTRO GOVERNMENT FOR ITS FIRST SIX MONTHS OF 1959, SAID THE ASSASSINATION PLANS ARE "WELL FORMULATED" BUT REFUSED TO^DIVULGE DETAILS. HE SAID HE DID NOT WANT TO GIVE CASTRO ANY INFORMATION THAT MIGHT ALLOW HIM TO ESCAPE.

"FOR BETRAYING THE PURPOSES OF THE REVOLUTION, CASTRO DESERVES DEATH ... AND HE'LL GET IT, " SAID URPUTIA.

URRUTIA, 62, SAID HE IS STARTING A CAMPAIGN IN THE UNITED STATES AND LATIN AMERICA'TO UNITE ABOUT 15 ANTI-CASTRO ORGANIZATIONS UNDER ONE EANNER. HE PREDICTED THAT THE "VAST MAJORITY" OF CUBANS NOW LIVING UNDER CASTRO WOULD NOW SUPPORT CASTRO'S OVERTHROW BY EXILE GROUPS.

URRUTIA IS NOW A PROFESSOR OF LATIN AMERICAN HISTORY AT C. W. POST COLLEGE IN NEW YORK CITY.
