MIAMI, FLA., APRIL 3 (AP)-HAVANA RADIO SAID TONIGHT THAT FIDEL CASTRO'S GOVERNMENT SENT A SHARP PROTEST TO THE UNITED NATIONS ABOUT THE EXPLOSION OF A PACKAGE IN THE HANDS OF A CUBAN OFFICIAL IN NEW YORK.

THE BROADCAST STATEMENT, MONITORED IN MIAMI, SAID THE INCIDENT SHOWS THE UN NO LONGER CAN FUNCTION NORMALLY IN THE UNITED STATES. IT ALSO REPEATED THE CASTRO REGIME'S FREQUENT ACCUSATIONS THAT THE UNITED STATES IS IN CAHOOTS WITH ANTI-CASTRO TERRORISTS.

"TERRORIST ACTS SUCH AS THIS ONE SHOW ONCE MORE THAT CONDITIONS IN THE UNITED STATES NO LONGER PERMIT THE NORMAL FUNCTIONING THERE OF THE UNITED NATIONS," SAID THE STATEMENT, ADDRESSED TO THE UN SECRETARY-GENERAL.

"SUCH ATTEMPTS, MR. SECRETARY GENERAL, INVOLVING CUBAN COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES, ARE CARRIED OUT WITH THE EVIDENT COMPLICITY OF THE AUTHORITIES AND IMPERIALIST GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES WHO PICK UP AND PROTECT CRIMINALS AND TRAITORS AND GIVE THEM MATERIALS."

HAVANA RADIO SAID THE OFFICIAL WAS INJURED BY AN EXPLOSIVE CALLED C-4, WHICH IT SAID IS USED ONLY BY THE U.S. ARMY.
