

Anti-Castro Exiles in U.S. Seek \$1-Million War Chest

MIAMI (AP)—Cuban Power, an anti-Communist terrorist organization, has announced a campaign to raise a \$1-million anti-Castro war chest.

Orlando Bosch, newly appointed spokesman for the secret group, said at a news conference that emphasis in the anti-Castro activity would be on crippling shipping to Cuba and on sabotage inside Cuba.

"The United States blockade against Cuba has been ineffective," said the spokesman for Cuban Power, which says it has bombed many ships of countries trading with the Castro regime.

"We will see to it that insurance rates for lines shipping to Castro go sky high," Mr. Bosch said.
