The Dental Work **Draft Evaders**

Los Angeles Federal agents arrested ten men yesterday on charges they evaded the draft by claiming to be un-dergeing orthodontic treat. dergoing orthodontic treat-

ment. The FBI said the arrests followed an indictment by the Federal Grand Jury here which charged the men "knowingly and willfully" evaded service in the armed forces by falsely represent-ing they were "undergoing active, continuing orthodontic treatment."

The indictments culminat-

ed a lengthy grand jury in-vestigation of possible draft evasion through fraudulent use of medical and dental devices.

The grand jury twice sub-poenaed Dr. Bernard Bender, a Woodland Hills dentist, who failed to appear and who subsequently was held in Cuba when his yacht ran aground there.

A Claremont Colleges chaplain, the Rev. Gordon Ver Plank, also as questioned by the panel about his draft counseling activities.
