3 Charged in Airliner Crash

Caracas

Venezuelan authorities yesterday formally accused Dr. Orlando Bosch, an anti-Castro Cuban exile leader, and two Venezuelan photographers of responsibility for the October 6 Cuban airliner crash off Barbados that killed all 73 persons aboard.

The photographers accused

with Bosch were Freddy Lugo and Hernan Ricardo Lozano. The two were arrested on the Caribbean island of Trinidad and returned to Caracas.

Cuba has claimed the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency was involved in the crash and on this basis renounced the 1973 U.S.-Cuban air privacy treaty.
