

'A Whitewash,' Says Gen. Walker

DALLAS—(UPI) — Former Maj. Gen. Edwin A. Walker, calling the Warren Commission report a whitewash, said today "there's bound to have been a plot" between Lee Harvey Oswald and his convicted killer, Jack Ruby.

"It's perfectly obvious that there was enough relationship between Rubenstein and Oswald to prove there was a conspiracy," Walker said.

Ruby's name was Rubenstein until he had it legally changed.

Walker accepted the Warren Commission conclusion that it was Oswald who shot at and narrowly missed him April 10, 1963 in his home.

He said last March the Commission report would

hide the true facts surrounding the assassination.

Walker said "it certainly appears there was some sort of conspiracy to avoid bringing Oswald to light after he shot at me."
