Ex-Sheriff in Mississippi Is Suing Time Magazine

PHILADELPHIA, Miss., Aug. 7 (UPI)—A \$50,000 damage suit against the publishers of Time magazine was filed in Cir-cuit Court Wednesday by Law-rence Rainey, former Neshoba County Sheriff. Rainey, acquitted last year of

Rainey, acquitted last year of Federal conspiracy charges in the 1964 slaying of three civil right workers, alleged in the suit that Time wrongly implied in an article in February that he had been found guilty in the conspiracy trial at Merid-ian last October. The suit also said that Time wrongly stated that Travis Buckley was chief defense coun-sel for Rainey and 17 other white men in the case. Buckley, who since has been disbarred, was attorney for the alleged Ku Klux Klan leader, Sam Bowers Jr. while Rainey was represented by a Jackson attorney.
