

Klan Leader Leaves Prison

DANBURY, Conn., Jan. 9 (AP)—J. Robert Jones, one of several Ku Klux Klan leaders who had been imprisoned for contempt of Congress, left the Federal Correctional Institution here today, saying he was still in charge of his KKK organization in North Carolina. Jones, asked about his plans, said he was heading "back South of the Mason-Dixon Line, where there's no damn Yankee dandruff [snow]."
