DALLAS, Feb. 23 (AP)— Bursting bombs scattered rightwing hate leaflets in Dallas, Carthage, Tex., and Little Rock, Ark., Saturday night. Damage was believed to be less than \$2,000.

The leaflets, right-wing literature directed at socialism and bureaucracy, bore a "minutemen" signature and were headed "Fight the Parasites" "Stop the Bureaucratic Tyrants" and "Death to Socialism."

The bomb blast in Dallas

The bomb blast in Dallas occurred in a parking lot near the First Baptist Church and the offices of the Internal Rev-

enue Service. The Litte Rock blast was in a parking lot of television station KTHV. A plane was believed to have dropped the third bomb at Carthage. A number of cars were damaged.
