14 Men Arraigned
On Murder Charge
In Kentucky Battle

BEREA, Ky., Sept. 2 (AP)
Fourteen men were arraigned today on charges of murder in a gun fight during which two men died and several others were wounded.

One of the victims was white and one Negro. Eight of those arraigned were white, six Negro.

An examining trial for all 14 men was tentatively scheduled for next Monday.

The State police said the shooting broke out yesterday following a rally in a vacant lot by the National States' Rights party, a rightist organization. Some witnesses reported that as many as 40 shots were fired.
