DALLAS, AUG. 3 (AP)-A CUBAN EXILE ASSERTED YESTERDAY THAT RUSSIAN MISSILES WITH A RANGE OF 1,200 MILES ARE POISED BENEATH THE OCEAN'S SURFACE OFF THE SHORES OF COMMUNIST CUBA.

DR. FERNANDO PENABAZ, A LAWYER WHO LEFT CUBA AFTER FIDEL CASTRO SEIZED POWER, SAID "USUALLY ACCURATE SOURCES" RELAYED INFORMATION ABOUT THE ROCKETS TO HIM.

HE DESCRIBED THE SOVIET-CONTROLLED MISSILES AS RUSSIAN GOLEM II'S. HE SAID THAT AS FAR AS HE KNOWS THERE IS A SINGLE BASE AND IT IS OFF THE NORTH COAST OF CUBA ABOUT 40 MILES WEST OF HAVANA.

HE HAD NO WAY OF KNOWING HOW MANY ROCKETS ARE DEPLOYED AT THE UNDERWATER BASE, THE CUBAN SAID.

PENABAZ SPOKE AT A SESSION OF THE REV. BILLY JAMES HARGIS' CHRISTIAN CRUSADE.
