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NEW YORK (AP)-H.L. HUNT SAID THURSDAY HE PLANNED TO BRING OUT A WEEKLY 30-MINUTE TELEVISION VERSION OF HIS "LIFE LINE" RADIO PROGRAM.

HUNT, A MULTIMILLIONAIRE DALLAS OIL MAN WHO SAID HE PREFERS BEING CALLED A CONSTRUCTIVE TO CONSERVATIVE, HAS DEVOTED A PART OF HIS INCOME AND TIME IN RECENT YEARS TO CONSERVATIVE CAUSES.

HE SAID HE WILL USE HIS YOUTH FREEDOM SPEAKERS ON THE SHOW, WHICH WILL BE TELEVISED INITIALLY ON ABOUT 35 TO 40 STATIONS. THE FREEDOM SPEAKERS ARE PERSONS BETWEEN 17 AND 23 HE HAS TRAINED TO DELIVER THREE-MINUTE SPEECHES TO CIVIC CLUBS AND CHURCHES.

THE "LIFE LINE" RADIO PROGRAM CURRENTLY IS PRESENTED SEVEN DAYS A WEEK ON 460 RADIO STATIONS.

HUNT WAS IN NEW YORK TO PROMOTE HIS LATEST BOOK, "ALPACA REVISITED." ALPACA IS A MYTHICAL, UTOPIAN SOCIETY THAT HUNT HAS CREATED AND DEVISED A CONSTITUTION FOR.

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
