Pueblo-Leak

WASHINGTON AP -- There are indications at least one high Pentagon official has leaked highly classified information about the official to right-wing extremist organizations, according to Sen. Stephen M. Young.

"It is obvious that many facts concerning the Pueblo incident were furnished to these right-wing publications prior to the time they were revealed to the Naval Board of Inquiry investigating the affair," Young told the Senate Thursday.

The Ohio Democratic official said if the leaks about the spy ship continue he will ask for a probe by the Senate Armed Services Committee, of which he is a member.

"It is clear that they received their advance information from right-wing sympathizers holding sensitive jobs in the Defense Department," Young contended.
