NEW YORK, JULY 7 (AP)-THE VOICE OF MRS. NGO DINH NHU CROSSED THE ATLANTIC OCEAN BY TELEPHONE TONIGHT TO ADDRESS A "TRUTH RALLY" OF THE FLUSHING CONSERVATIVE CLUB, BUT HER SPEECH FROM PARIS LASTED ONLY A FEW MINUTES.

POOR CONNECTIONS MADE HER PLANNED SEVEN-PAGE SPEECH INCOMPREHENSIBLE AND IT WAS CUT OFF WITHIN MINUTES. A TAPE OF HER SPEECH WHICH WAS PLAYED LATER ALSO WAS UNINTELLIGIBLE AND FINALLY THE SPEECH WAS READ BY JOHN SULLIVAN, CHAIRMAN OF THE RALLY.

THE CLUB HAD INVITED MRS. NHU, WIDOW OF THE BROTHER OF THE LATE SOUTH VIETNAMESE PRESIDENT NGO DINH DIEM, TO ADDRESS THE RALLY IN PERSON.

HER VISA APPLICATION FROM PARIS WAS DENIED LAST MONTH BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT ON GROUNDS THAT HER ACTIVITIES WOULD BE "PREJUDICIAL TO THE PUBLIC INTEREST."

IN HER P SPEECH, MRS. NHU SAID "A NEW CHAPTER OF TRUTH NEEDS TO BE TOLD," AND ACCUSED THE UNITED STATES OF DESTROYING "AN INDEPENDENT AND CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNMENT (IN SOUTH VIET NAM), TO REPLACE IT WITH A MILITARY DICTATORSHIP."

THE RALLY IN WAS ATTENDED BY ABOUT 300.
