The police disclosed today that in hunting a fugitive in the Ben Barka kidnapping they stumbled on a ring smuggling narcotics into the United States.

Mehdi Ben Barka, the Moroccan Opposition leader, was taken away here on Oct. 29, 1965, by two members of the Paris narcotics squad. They said they had been asked to do it by Antoine Lopez, who said he was doing the Moroccan secret police a favor.

Lopez, an official at Orly Airport here, was an agent of the French counterespionage service and, on at least one occasion, a valuable tipster for the United States Bureau of Narcotics. He was also a close friend of the gangster-informer Georges Boucheseiche, to whose home Mr. Ben Barka was taken
