Yaiohird Kobayashi, also an archeologist, said he believed that the face of the assassin and any accomplices would ap-pear in film if shot with his ordinary 35-mm, camera at the spot where the President was fatally wounded in Dallas on Nov. 22, 1963. Mr. Kobayashi, son of a miner and born in Sapporo, Japan, said, however, he want-ed no part in crime detection because he did not want to make enemies.

Mr. Mizuno said he did not know whether the filmy substance forming the faces shown on the many pho-tos had been caused by spirit photography. It might be a re-sult of light or shadow, he said.
