Reuther Says Hoover Defied Order for Shooting Inquiry

WASHINGTON, Sept. 12 (UPI)

J. Edgar Hoover refused to investigate the shootings of two labor leaders in the nineteenforties although ordered to doso by Attorney General Tom Clark, one of the victims said yesterday.

Victor Reuther, retired United Auto Workers leader, told a group of union members that he found out about the defiance of instructions by the former Federal Bureau of Investigation director after obtaining Justice Department documents under the Freedom of Information Act.
