SALT LAKE CITY, MARCH 10 (AP)-NORMAN P. MICHAUD, 43, OF FREDONIA, ARIZ., WAS FOUND GUILTY TONIGHT OF THREATENING THE LIFE OF PRESIDENT JOHNSON.

A 12-MEMBER JURY RETURNED THE VERDICT IN U.S. DISTRICT COURT AFTER 2 1/2 HOURS DELIBERATION.

A GOVERNMENT COMPLAINT CHARGED MICHAUD WITH PLACING A TELEPHONE CALL FROM KANAB, UTAH TO THE WHITE HOUSE ON JAN. 20 AND TELLING GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL HE TOOK PART IN THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND WOULD KILL JOHNSON.

JUDGE WILLIS W. RITTER SAID THE MAXIMUM SENTENCE FOR THE OFFENSE IS ONE YEAR'S IMPRISONMENT OR A \$5,000 FINE, OR BOTH.

THE FOUR-DAY TRIAL INCLUDED TESTIMONY OF MICHAUD AND HIS MOTHER THAT HE DID NOT MAKE THE CALL.
