MALCOLM KILDUFF, ASSISTANT WHITE HOUSE PRESS SECRETARY, SAID
THE STOWAWAY WAS DISCOVERED WHEN THOSE ABOARD WERE CHECKED AGAINST A
PASSENGER LIST.

KILDUFF SAID THE MAN IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS CORDON DU BOIS, AND PRODUCED A CALLING CARD WHICH DESCRIBED HIM AS A SALES REPRESENTATIVE FOR RADIO STATION WBCN, BOSTON. THE PRESS AIDE SAID THE MAN RELATED THAT HIS BOSS HAD TOLD HIM TO GET ABOARD THE PLANE AND COVER JOHNSON'S CAMPAIGN TRIP.

WHILE THE PLANE WAS AIRBORNE, RADIO CONTACT WAS MADE WITH AUTHORITIES AT WBCN WHO SAID THEY EMPLOYED A GORDON DU BOIS BUT KNEW NOTHING OF ANY PLANS TO HAVE HIM COVER THE CAMPAIGN.
