

Secret Service Had a List

The Secret Service was on the lookout yesterday for between 10 and 15 persons considered potentially dangerous during President Johnson's visit in San Francisco.

Agent in charge Tom Hanson said none of the persons on the list is known to have entered San Francisco while the President was here.

One of those on the list, a man using the name John F. O'Rourke, was the subject of an all-points police alert after it was reported he was carrying a .22 caliber semi-automatic rifle and 300 rounds of ammunition.

O'Rourke, also known as Walter Davis Hendrickson and Allen David Savage, is suspected of having sent threatening letters to the President.

He was last seen in Ogden, Utah, where he checked out of a motel at midnight on Monday.
