**Ex-Student in Wichita Held  
In Threat to Kill President**

WICHITA, Kan., Nov. 11 (UPI)—Charles V. Blackmon, 25-year-old former Wichita State University student and self-avowed leftist, was arrested Saturday and held on a Federal charge of threatening to kill President Jhonsoon.

Police Chief Eugene Pond said that Mr. Blackmon was arrested at his home shortly after midnight on a complaint signed by Secret Service agents. President Johnson brought his Veterans Day campaign for peace to McConnell Air Force Base for one hour today.

United States Commissioner Arthur Johnson set \$25,000 bond at a hearing. Mr. Blackmon was moved to the Sedgwick County jail to await arraignment.

Mr. Blackmon said he was the local representative of the national office of the Students for a Democratic Society, a militant student organization.
