TUCSON, ARIZ., NOV. 1 (AP)-SUPPORTERS OF DEMOCRATIC VICE PRESIDENTIAL NOMINEE HUBERT HUMPHREY WERE TURNED AWAY AT TUCSON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TONIGHT BECAUSE OF TWO ANONYMOUS ASSASSINATION THREATS.

JACK CHESNUT, A WASHINGTON AIDE OF THE MINNESOTA SENATOR, SAID HE RECEIVED ONE OF THEM BY PHONE EARLIER IN THE WEEK AFTER HE ARRIVED TO PREPARE FOR HUMPHREY'S APPEARANCE.

POLICE LT. JIM CARTER SAID THE SECOND ONE CAME VIA AN ANONYMOUS PHONE CALL TO POLICE HEADQUARTERS TODAY.

THE LANDING LOCATION OF HUMPHREY'S PLANE WAS ALTERED, AND AT FIRST, OFFICERS WOULDN'T EVEN ALLOW DEMOCRATIC PARTY LEADERS AND NEWSMEN NEAR THE SPOT.

ULTIMATELY, THEY WERE ALLOWED TO GREET HUMPHREY WHEN HE STEPPED OUT OF THE PLANE.

OTHER WELL-WISHERS WERE KEPT AT A DISTANCE. AFTER LANDING, HUMPHREY HEADED TO DOWNTOWN TUCSON FOR A RALLY. THERE WERE NO INCIDENTS.

ORIGINALLY, HE HAD PLANNED TO REMAIN IN TUCSON OVERNIGHT, BUT CHESNUT SAID HUMPHREY WOULD RETURN TO LOS ANGELES TONIGHT BECAUSE OF THE THREATS. JH936PMS NM
