ITS BASE WOULD BE MADE OF GRANITE WITH FOUR BRONZE PANELS SHOWING ON A MAP THE ROUTE OF THE PRESIDENTIAL PARADE ON THE DAY OF THE ASSASSINATION, A LAYOUT SHOWING THE LOCATION OF THE SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY BUILDING FROM WHICH THE SHOTS WERE FIRED, AND A BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT FINDINGS.
