DALLAS, TEX., MARCH 7 (AP)-THE DALLAS PARK BOARD APPROVED SPECIFICATIONS MONDAY FOR AN \$8,000 PLAQUE TO MARK THE SITE OF THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

KENNEDY DIED IN DALLAS NOV. 22, 1963, ON THE WESTERN EDGE OF THE DOWNTOWN SECTION OF TOWN.
