## Dallas Memorial Marker Up at Last

DALLAS - (AP) - There first-time visitors to Dallas niversary of the assassina-still make their way to the tion the bronze historical foot of Main street.

There they walk around the roughly triangular grassy plots of Dealey Plaza, inspect the orange brick Texas School Book depository across Elm street, and point to the sixth floor window at the southeast corner. For it had indicated the Kennedys was here on Nov. 22, 1963, that an assassin ended the life of President John F. Kennedy.

Following the assassinasuggestions for memorials to honor Kennedy and mark the site of the tragedy.
