A Kennedy Library Site Abandoned

The John F. Kennedy Library Corp. said yesterday it has abandoned plans to build a memorial museum to the late president in Cambridge. The corporation said the Kennedy archives still may be housed here.

The \$27 million librarymuseum was projected to open in 1976. But it had aroused considerable opposition from residents of the congested Harvard Square area.

Library president Stephen E. Smith, a brother-in-law of the late President Kennedy, said the library corporation "is giving renewed and serious consideration" to two alternatives: build the museum and archives outside of Cambridge or build the Kennedy archives in Cambridge and the museum elsewhere.
