In fact, so much so that it's easy to make the mistake of comparing one ohannel of one version with a different chanrel in another version without even realizing. Well, Sawyer A \& B save you the trouble of getting swdtched up, on account of about $50 \%$ of the chan 2 Sawyer A pages being mixed in with the chan Sewyer B pages! And it is done so neatly \& with so much care that the pugzo sequences, the hours \& minutes, mesh in beautifuliy. Set you could spend a hundred hours comparing the various versions of the logs without discovering this. $-388-400$

To set your Sawyers in order, mark your pages conspiouously like this at the page bottoms:
