The California Section of the State Library maintains two major indexes. One is our information file which includes selectively indexed items pertaining to California persons, events and places which appear in books, magazines and newspapers. It is arranged by subject.

Our second is an inclusive index of the San Francisco CHRONICLE since 1913, with the exception of some sports, comics, fashions and the like. Also appearing in this index are the San Francisco CALL, 1904-1913, and the San Francisco EXAMINER, 1913-1928.

The two indexes contain approximately 2-1/2 million entries.

Our newspaper holdings contain files of early and current California newspapers covering the entire state. Many of the papers are now on microfilm. These may be borrowed through a public or college library, if they are not in the library's collection and if microfilm reading facilities are available.
