

Sherman Skolnick, whom the AP calls a legal researcher, filed suit in the Federal District Court in Chicago today asking that the Warren Commission Report on the assassination of President John Kennedy be declared void. The suit charges the National Archives in Washington with suppressing documents which show that the death of the President was the product of a conspiracy rather than of a lone assassin. The suit asserts that five conspirators planned to kill President Kennedy at the Army-Air Force football game^{2 Nov 63}, but the attempt was rescheduled for Dallas three weeks later after the President cancelled his appearance at the football game. Eleven documents were attached to the suit, including three reports of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that were recently declassified by the National Archives.
