MRS. ROBERTS (200)

DALLAS, TEX., JAN. 9 (AP)-"HE CAME RUNNING LIKE THE DICKENS AND I SAID TO HIM 'YOU SURE ARE IN A HURRY.' BUT HE DIDN'T SAY ANYTHING-- JUST RAN IN HIS ROOM, GOT A SHORT TAN COAT AND RAN BACK OUT."

HE WAS LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND HE HAD JUST KILLED THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

THE WOMAN WHO NEVER GOT A REPLY WAS MRS. EARLINE ROBERTS, A PLUMPISH, BESPECTACLED WIDOW WHO RAN THE ROOMING HOUSE AT 1026 NORTH BECKLEY WHERE OSWALD LIVED AS O. H. LEE, PLOTTED THE ASSASSINATION OF JOHN F. KENNEDY IN 1963.

TODAY, MRS. ROBERTS WAS APPARENTLY SEIZED BY A HEART ATTACK AT HER HOME, 212 W. WOODIN. SHE WAS RUSHED TO PARKLAND HOSPITAL WHERE SHE DIED AT 5:15 A.M.

MRS. ROBERTS, INTERVIEWED BY THE DALLAS MORNING NEWS, JUST AFTER THE ASSASSINATION "HE WAS ALWAYS IN BED BY 9:30 OR 10 P.M."

IN CLEANING HIS \$8 PER WEEK, 5 BY 12-FOOT ROOM, MRS. ROBERTS HAD NOTICED THAT OSWALD WAS NEAT, READ WESTERNS, ATE A LOT OF FRUIT AND MADE SANDWICHES IN HIS ROOM.

MRS. ROBERTS, WIDOW OF THE LATE BUILDING CONTRACTOR, OLAN ROBERTS, WAS WIDELY QUOTED IN NEWSPAPERS AND MAGAZINES AND INTERVIEWED NUMEROUS TIMES ON TELEVISION AND RADIO FOLLOWING THE ASSASSINATION.

A NATIVE OF TENNESSEE, MRS. ROBERTS MOVED TO DALLAS IN 1940 AND HAD LIVED HERE SINCE.
