WASHINGTON, FEB. 2 (AP)-ESCORTED BY SECRET SERVICE AGENTS, MRS.
MARINA OSWALD ARRIVED IN WASHINGTON TONIGHT FROM DALLAS, TEX. TO
TESTIFY BEFORE THE WARREN COMMISSION INVESTIGATING THE ASSASSINATION
OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

MRS. OSWALD, THE WIDOW OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WHO WAS ACCUSED OF KILLING KENNEDY IN DALLAS LAST NOV. 22, IS TO APPEAR TOMORROW BEFORE THE COMMISSION AS A VOLUNTARY WITNESS.

ON HER ARRIVAL BY PLANE, MRS. OSWALD WAS PROMPTLY HURRIED INTO A WAITING CAR BY SECRET SERVICE MEN.

SHE DECLINED TO TALK WITH REPORTERS AS SHE LEFT THE COMMERICAL AIRLINER, HER ONLY WORD BEING "NO" WHEN ASKED FOR A COMMENT.

ACCOMPANIED BY THREE UNIDENTIFIED MEN, ONE CARRYING HER 2-YEAR-OLD DAUGHTER, JUNE LEE, MRS. OSWALD UNSMILINGLY LEFT THE PLANE AFTER OTHER PASSENGERS HAD DEPARTED.

MRS. OSWALD IS SCHEDULED TO APPEAR AT COMMISSION OFFICES HERE TOMORROW (10 A.M. EST).

SECRET'SERVICE MEN' WERE WAITING AT WASHINGTON NATIONAL AIRPORT BEFORE THE PLANE ARRIVED. OTHER SECRET SERVICE MEN WERE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN ABOARD THE BIG PLANE.

AS MRS. OSWALD WALKED TO THE WAITING AUTOMOBILE, A REPORTER INQUIRED IF JOHN THORNE OF GRAND PRAIRIE, TEX., WHO IS HER LAWYER WAS WITH THE GROUP. A MAN WHO WAS AT MRS. OSWALD'S SIDE MERELY NODDED. TO FURTHER INQUIRIES HE SAID:

"DON'T ASK ME ANY MORE QUESTIONS."

SECRET SERVICE MEN ALSO DECLINED TO ANSWER INQUIRIES.
