Dallas, May 20 (AP)- An accounting filed with a court clerk today showed Mrs. Marina Oswald, widow of accused presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, has received \$70,795 since Jack Ruby killed her husband last Nov. 24.

This information came from James H. Martin, business manager for Mrs. Oswald; John M. Thorne, her lawyer-agent, and Paul W. Leech, law partner of Thorne. Martin and Thorne agreed to the accounting after Mrs. Oswald filed suit asking it April 7.

Mrs. Oswald has been given \$65,795 by sympathetic individuals and groups, according to the accounting filed in the court of Dist. Judge Dee Brown Walker. It added that she received \$5,000 for a photograph of Oswald which appeared on the cover of Life magazine.

Mrs. Oswald, Russian-born and speaking limited English, stated in filing the suit last month that she did not understand contracts signed last December with Thorne and Martin.

Under the contracts Martin was to receive 15 per cent and Thorne 10 per cent of Mrs. Oswald's income.
