Ann Arbor, Mich., Dec. 23 (AP)- Mrs. Marina Oswald, widow of the alleged slayer of President Kennedy, has enrolled in the University of Michigan's English Language Institute.

The University said today that Mrs. Oswald had enrolled for an eight-week course of instruction in English. It said she would be one of about 100 students taking the course. Classes begin Jan. 7.

The University said the institute specialized in the teaching of English as a foreign language and that students came to it from throughout the world.

Mrs. Oswald arrived in this country from Russia in 1962. The University said she was interested in the course because of "her limited knowledge of English.

During her stay, Mrs. Oswald will be sponsored by the First Presbyterian Church of Ann Arbor.
