DALLAS, TEX., FEB. 25 (AP)-THE WIDOW OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, NOW REMARRIED, LIVES A QUIET LIFE IN A PLUSH DALLAS SUBURB AS CONTROVERSY CONTINUES AROUND THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND FEDERAL INVESTIGATIONS OF IT, A DALLAS NEWSPAPER SAID TODAY.

THE DALLAS TIMES HERALD SAID MARINA OSWALD PORTER HAS FEW VISITORS. FEDERAL AGENTS, THE NEWSPAPER SAID, APPARENTLY ARE NO LONGER INTERESTED IN THE SLIGHT, BLONDE RUSSIAN WOMAN WHO CAME TO AMERICA AS OSWALD'S BRIDE.

MARINA AND HER NEW HUSBAND, TAVERN KEEPER KENNETH PORTER, CURRENTLY LIVE IN A HOUSE ON EMERSON STREET IN UNIVERSITY PARK, A DALLAS SUBURB.

THE NEWSPAPER SAID SHE STILL KEEPS THE OUTWARD APPEARANCE OF A YOUNG SUBURBAN HOUSEWIFE--PUSHING HER GROCERY CART IN A NEARBY SUPERMARKET AND DRESSING STYLISHLY WHEN SHE APPEARS IN HER YARD OR ON SHOPPING TOURS.

THE PORTERS DO NOT HAVE SERVANTS AND MARINA APPARENTLY DOES HER OWN COOKING AND HOUSEWORK. THE NEWSPAPER QUOTED A NEIGHBOR AS DESCRIBING HER AS "A GOOD MOTHER."
