HANOI-KENNEDY

TOKYO, NOV. 24 (AP)-"KENNEDY IS DEAD," BUT THE REACTIONARIES NOW RULING IN THE UNITED STATES STILL FOLLOW HIS AGGRESSIVE PATH," COMMUNIST NORTH VIET NAM'S OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER NHAN DAN SAID SUNDAY.

THE PAPER'S EDITORIAL WAS QUOTED BY RADIO HANOI MONITORED IN TOKYO. IT REFLECTED COMMUNIST CHINA'S REACTIONS TO THE ASSASSINATION, SHARPLY CONTRASTING WITH MOSCOW'S EXPRESSIONS OF SORROW.

THE ORGAN OF THE NORTH VIET NAM COMMUNIST PARTY AVOIDED SAYING WHETHER IT WAS HAPPY OR SADDEN BY KENNEDY'S DEATH.

IT AVERRED KENNEDY'S DEATH HAD PROMPTED "DIFFERENT REACTIONS AMONG VARIOUS CIRCLES IN THE WORLD. SOME ARE GLAD AND OTHERS INDIGNANT."

"GLAD ARE KENNEDY'S OPPONENTS IN THE UNITED STATES AND IN OTHER COUNTRIES OF THE FREE WORLD OF THE INEFFICIENT LACKEYS OUSTED BY KENNEDY, SUCH AS THE REMNANTS OF THE NGO BINH DIEM CLIQUE," THE COMMUNIST PAPER SAID, ADDING:

"MEANWHILE, THE FLUNKYS OF THE U.S. IMPERIALISTS WHO HAVE JUST BEEN BROUGHT TO POWER, LIKE THE LEADERS OF THE SAIGON COUP (THAT OVERTHREW AND KILLED PRESIDENT NGO BINH DIEM) ARE SHAKING IN EVERY LIMB."

"THE REVISIONISTS (TITO AND KHRUSHCHEV) ARE STUPEFIED AND HAVE EXPRESSED SORROW AT THE LOSS OF A BELLICOSE RINGLEADER OF IMPERIALISM WHO THEY SAID HAD GOODWILL FOR PEACE AND WAS NEITHER IMPERIALIST NOR BELLICOSE," IT SAID.

NHAN DAN SAID "INDIVIDUAL ASSASSINATION IS A REGULAR FEATURE INHERENT TO THE SOCIAL NATURE OF THE CAPITALIST WORLD OF WHICH THE UNITED STATES IS THE CENTER."

KENNEDY'S DEATH, THE HANOI ORGAN CLAIMED, RESULTED FROM CONTRADICTION AMONG THE DIFFERENT FORCES IN THE UNITED STATES "WHICH SCRAMBLE FOR POWER AND POSITION."

"KENNEDY COULD NOT FIND A WAY OUT FROM THE GENERAL CRISIS. CONTRADICTIONS AMONG DIFFERENT MONOPOLIST GROUPS AND BETWEEN THE DEMOCRATIC AND REPUBLICAN PARTIES BECAME EVER MORE ACUTE," IT SAID.

"SEEING THAT THE MEASURES TAKEN BY KENNEDY YIELDED NOTHING FOR THE FINANCIERS BUT ONLY BENEFITTED THE KENNEDY GROUP, HIS OPPONENTS DID NOT HESITATE TO SHOOT HIM DOWN.

"TO BRING AN OPPONENT DOWN BY BALLOTS OR BULLETS IS A STUNT OF STRUGGLE IN THE FREE WORLD," THE HANOI COMMUNIST PARTY ORGAN DECLARED.
