CHINA KENNEDY,

TOKYO, NOV. 24 (AP)-COMMUNIST CHINA'S CONTROLLED PRESS SUNDAY IGNORED PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION.

THE NEW CHINA NEWS AGENCY IN ITS DAILY REVIEW OF PEKING'S MAJOR PAPERS SAID THEY "GAVE PROMINENCE" TO ARTICLES ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE COMMUNIST CHINA-NORTH KOREA AGREEMENT FOR ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL COOPERATION.

THE AGENCY SATURDAY TERSELY REPORTED WITHOUT COMMENT THAT PRESIDENT KENNEDY WAS SHOT TO DEATH WHILE RIDING THROUGH A DALLAS STREET FRIDAY.

PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S DEATH WAS MENTIONED NOWHERE IN THE NCNA PRESS REVIEW.

PEKING PEOPLE'S DAILY AND OTHER PAPERS, NCNA SAID, DEVOTED THEIR INTERNATIONAL COLUMNS TO ANTI-TITO ARTICLES AND REPORTS CAMBODIA WAS SEEKING AN INTERNATIONAL GUARANTEE OF ITS NEUTRALITY.
