"THE ONE THING A WOMAN IN DISTRESS, DOWNED BY TWO COUNTRIES, NEEDS IS MONEY AND THAT'S WHY I WANT TO START THIS FUND. LIKE EVERY OTHER WOMAN I FEEL A DEEP SYMPATHY FOR MRS. KENNEDY BUT MY THOUGHTS KEEP GOING BACK TO THE OTHER WIDOW, THE WOMAN NOBODY WANTS."
