## Kennedy Shooting 12/19/63

# Hate Literature at College?

### Dallas

The Dallas Times Herald said yesterday that the Secret Service is investigating the appearance of hate-Kennedy literature at Arlington State College near here the day before the former President was assassinated in Dallas on November 22.

The Secret Service also is probing a remark, the Times Herald said, by a student who is believed to have said it would be possible for him to shoot the President from an office window.

Agents, accompanied by

detectives from the Arlington police, questioned students of a night history class Tuesday night.

One of the students said the agents were primarily concerned with the remark of the student. The newspaper did not name the students.

The day before Mr. Kennedy's assassination, literature attacking the late President appeared on the campus of the school, which is about 15 miles west of Dallas.

The literature was believed to be of the same type that was distributed in Dallas the

next morning. The sheets contained two pictures of President Kennedy with the words, "wanted for treason."

This sheet included criticism of many of the President's policies and actions.
