**'Fair Play
For Cuba
Unit Dies'**

The Fair Play for Cuba Committee, with which the late Lee H. Oswald said he was affiliated, reportedly is disbanding.

The New York Times yesterday quoted unidentified persons formerly active in the pro-Castro group as saying they are discussing how the committee's affairs can be wound up. But they said they are finding it difficult getting someone to attend to the liquidation.

The Times said the group began disintegrating before the November 22 assassination of President Kennedy, an act charged to Oswald, an avowed Marxist.

Oswald distributed the committee's literature in New Orleans. Supporters say the group was dealt a fatal blow when Oswald represented himself as one of its collaborators, according to the Times.
