THE NEWS SAID WORD HAS GONE OUT TO VARIOUS CHAPTERS OF THE FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA GROUP THAT THEY SHOULD RECONSTITUTE THEMSELVES UNDER THE NEW NAME.
