Milwaukee, April 2 (AP)- Dr. Exwists Revilo Oliver, controversial John Birch Society member and University of Illinois professor tonight called for "public hearings before legally constituted authorities" to find out more about President Kennedy's assassination.

Oliver spoke to a capacity crowd of about 500 persons at a downtown hotel after Marquette University refused to permit him to speak on campus.

Oliver's appearance was sponsored by atty. Peter W. Reiss of Sheboygan, Wis., a recent graduate of Marquette's law school.

Reiss, , who says he is a supporter of Sen. Marry Goldwater, R-Ariz., is an independent 6th Distr t delegate candidate in wisconsin's presidential primary next Thesday.

The classics professor critizized the warren commission that is investigating circumstances furrounding Kennedy's death.

Oliver said the function of that "unconstitutional and illegal commission" is "to cover up the crime which the communists had committed in Dallas."

He said that after careful study he had concluded that Kennedy's assassination "had been carried out on orders from the headquarters of the international communist conspiracy."

Oliver outlined his personal vigilance against "the international communist conspiracy" and said that as early as 1945 "I knew positively that the agents of theconspiracy had penetrated almost every agency of the federal government."

two pickets, who identified themselves as University of Illinois students, marched outside, the hotel with placards protesting Oliver. One read: "The extreme right and the extreme left and the lunatic fringe."
