RIO DE JANEIRO, APRIL 7 (AP)-DOCUMENTS SEIZED IN A ROUNDUP OF COMMUNISTS LINK RED CHINA AND CUBA TO A CAMPAIGN OF ASSASSINATION AND REVOLUTION PLANNED FOR BRAZIL THIS SPRING, MILITARY SOURCES SAID TODAY.

IN THE INLAND CAPITAL OF BRASILIA, DEPUTY EURIPIDES CARDOSO, A CONSERVATIVE, SAID HE WOULD PROPOSE IN CONGRESS AN IMMEDIATE DIPLOMATIC BREAK WITH FIDEL CASTRO'S CUBA. HE CHARGED THAT CUBAN AND OTHER COMMUNIST EMBASSIES WERE CENTERS OF AGITATION AND INFILTRATION.

CUBA'S AMBASSADOR TO BRASILIA, RAUL ROA KHOURY, LEFT SATURDAY FOR HAVANA. THE SON OF FOREIGN MINISTER RAUL ROA, HE WAS REPORTED GOING HOME FOR A VACATION.

POLICE AND ARMY RAIDS WERE UNCOVERING EVIDENCE OF SURPRISINGLY DEEP COMMUNIST INFILTRATION IN THE WAKE OF LAST WEEK'S OVERTHROW OF LEFTIST PRESIDENT JOAO GOULART BY GENERALS AND A GROUP OF POWERFUL STATE GOVERNORS.

JORNAL DO BRASIL SAID MORE THAN 3,000 COMMUNIST SUSPECTS AND TONS OF WEAPONS, SUBVERSIVE PROPAGANDA AND RADIO SETS HAD BEEN SEIZED IN THE RAIDS SINCE GOULART'S DOWNFALL.

IN RECIFE IN THE POVERTY-PLAGUED NORTHEAST, 4TH ARMY OFFICERS SHOWED REPORTERS DOCUMENTS THEY SAID WERE TAKEN FROM A MEMBER OF THE COMMUNIST-DOMINATED GENERAL WORKS COMMAND. THESE DOCUMENTS CALLED FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A COMMUNIST REGIME IN BRAZIL APRIL 2. OTHER DOCUMENTS SHOWED PLANS FOR A RED REVOLUTION TO BEGIN MAY 1. MANY OF THESE DOCUMENTS WERE SAID TO SHOW LINKS WITH PEKING AND HAVANA.

POLICE SAID THEY HAVE PICKED UP NUMEROUS CHINESE COMMUNIST AGENTS IN RIO DE JANEIRO CARRYING DOCUMENTS INDICATING THEY PLANNED TO ASSASSINATE KEY BRAZILIAN LEADERS WHEN THE REVOLUTION BEGAN.

AS THE RAIDS WERE IN PROGRESS, ABOUT 20 PERSONS TOOK REFUGE IN EMBASSIES. MANY OTHERS FLED TO NEARBY COUNTRIES, MOSTLY TO URUGUAY WHERE GOULART WAS GRANTED ASYLUM.

IN BRASILIA, CONGRESS CLEARED THE WAY FOR THE PROBABLE ELECTION OF GEN. HUMBERTO CASTELO BRANCO, CHIEF ARCHITECT OF THE REVOLUTION, TO SERVE AS INTERIM PRESIDENT FOR THE 20 REMAINING MONTHS OF GOULART'S TERM.

PASCHOAL RANIERI MAZZILLI, CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES PRESIDENT, WAS DECLARED TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF BRAZIL APRIL 2 WHEN CONGRESS RULED THAT THE PRESIDENCY WAS VACANT.
