OSWALD WIDOW PETITIONS TO ADMINISTER PROPERTY

Dallas Mar. 22 (UPI) - Mrs. Lee Harvey Oswald has asked a court to name her administrator of her husband's estate, it was disclosed today.

Her petition disclosed that the Russianborn widow of President Kennedy's assassin plans to become a citizen of the United States.

The 24-year-old Marina, who recently took a course to improve her English at the University of Michigan, said that she wanted to handle all the property her husband left.

The application appeared to be chiefly a legal maneuver. Oswald owned no real estate and had little money. After Jack L. Ruby shot him Nov. 24, 1965 he was buried on the proceeds of an insurance policy held by his mother Mrs. Marguerite Oswald of Fort Worth.
