LOS ANGELES, NOV. 24 (AP)-A LOS ANGELES MAN WHO TALKED WITH JACK RUBY SOON AFTER PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION QUOTED RUBY TODAY AS SAYING OVER THE TELEPHONE: "I'M CRYING...I CAN'T TAKE IT."

RUBY, 52, IS THE MAN CHARGED BY DALLAS POLICE WITH THE GUNSHOT SLAYING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WHO HAD BEEN ACCUSED OF ASSASSINATING KENNEDY.

AL GRUBER SAID OF RUBY, "HE STARTED TELLING ME HOW BAD HE FELT. HE SAID, 'I CAN'T TALK ANYMORE, I'M STARTING TO CRY... STAY HEALTHY.'

"HE LOVED THE PRESIDENT," GRUBER SAID. "I'LL TELL YOU THAT."

IRVING KATZ, ANOTHER LOS ANGELES ACQUAINTANCE OF RUBY, DESCRIBED HIM AS "A LITTLE VIOLENT" AND ADDED: "HE'D GO OFF THE DEEP END REAL QUICK AND GET HOT ABOUT SOMETHING."
