RUBY BEER LICENSE (200)

DALLAS, JAN. 28 (AP)-COUNTY JUDGE LEW STERRETT REFUSED TODAY TO RENEW A BEER AND WINE LICENSE FOR A STRIP TEASE NIGHT CLUB OPERATED BY JACK RUBY, KILLER OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ACCUSED ASSASSIN OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

STERRETT REFUSED TO RENEW THE LICENSE FOR THE CAROUSEL CLUB AFTER POLICE PROTESTED THE RENEWAL.

THE COUNTY JUDGE TOLD S.D. RUBY AND RALPH PAUL, WHO OWN INTERESTS IN THE CLUB, THAT THEY MUST MAKE AN ORIGINAL APPLICATION FOR A BEER AND WINE LICENSE AND THAT THEN A HEARING WOULD BE HELD ON THE NEW APPLICATION AT WHICH TIME THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD COULD REGISTER FORMAL PROTESTS.

STERRETT EXPLAINED THAT THE LAW REQUIRED A NEW APPLICATION WHEN A REQUEST FOR RENEWAL IS DISPUTED.

SHORTLY AFTER THE RENEWAL WAS REFUSED, RUBY, A BROTHER OF JACK RUBY, AND PAUL APPLIED FOR A NEW BEER AND WINE LICENSE UNDER THE NAME OF THE S & R CORP. AND LISTED OFFICERS AS PAUL, PRESIDENT, AND S.D. RUBY, VICE PRESIDENT, AND LEO TORTI, SECRETARY-TREASURER.

THE APPLICATION LISTS THE NAME OF THE CLUB AS THE BIG D COPA CLUB INSTEAD OF THE CAROUSEL CLUB.

PAUL AND RUBY SAID JACK RUBY DID NOT OWN AN INTEREST IN THE CAROUSEL CLUB, BUT MERELY OPERATED IT.

JACK RUBY, HOWEVER, IS LISTED ON A FORMER RENEWAL REQUEST AS VICE PRESIDENT OF THE CAROUSEL CLUB, BUT PAUL SAID HE WAS NOT AN OFFICER AND DID NOT OWN AN INTEREST AT THE TIME HE KILLED LEE HARVEY OSWALD.
