## AP, March 5, 1964, 254aes

Dallas -- Garnett Claude Hallmark, manager of an automobile parts store, told about two telephone calls by Ruby, and Ruby's apparent knowledge that Oswald was to be transferred from the city hail. Hallmark said the incident took place on Saturday, 24 hours after the assassination. The testimony went:

- Q. (by wade): "Did he say anything about the moving of Oswald from the city to the county jail?"
- A. "Yes."
- Q. "Did Ruby say anything with reference to the fact that he would be there?"
- A. "He told whoever he was talking to that he would be there."
- Q. "Did he want to be of service in connection with the transfer? was that the substance ?"
- A. "Yes, he passed that information along because he was close to the count by jail and also mentioned the possibility that the transfer would be delayed."

Oswald was to have been transferred at 10 a.m., but the move was delayed until after 11.

Under cross-examination, Hallmark said, "It appeared to me he had some information on this transfer and simply wanted to corroborate it."
